The "CANINE" trial is a multi-center study funded by the National Institutes of Health to investigate immunotherapy for dogs with malignant brain tumors. Treatment is paid for by the study and includes surgery to remove most or all of the tumor, treatment with an oncolytic virus, all post-operative imaging, hospitalization and associated rechecks.
